Registered Voters of the Cayuga Independent School District,

At a called meeting on February 5, 2024, the Cayuga ISD School Board of Trustees unanimously approved an order calling for a school bond election on May 4, 2024. Early voting and Election Day voting will take place exclusively at Cayuga ISD located at 17750 N State Hwy 287 in Cayuga TX 75832. Early voting will take place over seven days on April 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 29, and 30, from 8:00am to 5:00pm. Election Day voting will take place from 7:00am to 7:00pm.

On the ballot are two propositions. The ballot language is included with this letter. Each proposition stands alone on its own merit. Voters can cast their ballots for or against each proposition. There are four possible ballot choices:

1. Vote for proposition A and for proposition B
2. Vote for proposition A and against proposition B
3. Vote against proposition A and for proposition B
4. Vote against proposition A and against proposition B

Proposition A: \$6,000,000

This proposition will authorize the construction of a new addition to the Ag facility with new classrooms and the renovation and expansion of the existing shop space. This proposition also authorizes electrical upgrades to the main high school building, which was constructed in 1972, along with the paving of additional parking area.

Proposition B: \$6,000,000

This proposition calls for the demolition and relocation of the current baseball and softball fields. New replacement baseball and softball fields are proposed to be constructed adjacent to the football field. Portions of the left field section of the relocated baseball field would provide additional side access to the Ag facility following the path of a more level grade. The relocation of the softball field would provide space for additional parking options along with a paved band practice area.

The preliminary bond program analysis showing the tax impact is included with this letter. I want to encourage you to come out and make your voice heard by casting a ballot in this election.
